9:00–10:00am

Arrive, Register, and Explore the Ambassadors Hall

Buses arrive, drop off students, and park for free. (Drivers are welcome to join!) Students sign in with the registration tables, then explore the dozens of Missions Agencies serving Jesus locally and around the globe. Specific details will be provided to registered school groups on February 2, 2026.

10:00–11:30am

Worship & Message

A time of worship followed by James Bonney and Kaitlyn Penner discussing Jesus' Active Presence in and through us. Students will hear how John's vision of Jesus in Revelation 1 impacts their calling, and their affection for Jesus and His mission in the World. Greg Musselman will then lead students into a time of praying for the persecuted church.

11:30am–12:30pm

Lunch, and Explore the Ambassadors Hall

Students eat in the main sanctuary, and explore the Ambassadors Hall.

Note: Students should bring their own lunches, but additional food can be purchased from the Express Hut.

12:30–1:30pm

“Sent Out To Share & Show the Gospel”

Pastor Adam Shepski will equip students to express their faith in their everyday life, and to share the Gospel knowing that Jesus is present with them.

Note: We know some students may not be at the right place in their faith journey for this session, and some may wish to explore the Ambassadors hall more. We are leaving it to the teachers whether this session should be required or optional.

Students may continue eating lunch during this session if not finished.
