

Trail Mix Session Description

These rooms are available for people with common interests. You'll meet others who share those interests. Pop-in and introduce yourself. Share what draws you to the topic.

Going Global – Calling everyone interested in what it takes to go to the nations as an ambassador of Jesus. Related conversations may include the benefits and challenges of working in a new culture, and why it's hard to reach the unreached.

Justice (Environmental) – God has made us stewards of his creation. Part of our witness to the world is to live into this calling. How do you see your faith and stewardship intersecting? Do you have some encouraging examples of stewardship done well?

Relief and Development – The definition of relief is the “urgent provision of emergency aid to reduce immediate suffering during a crisis.” Development is “a long-term process to alleviate poverty through the sustainable improvement of the lives of individuals and communities. Join us to discuss how to do relief and development well.

Business & Technology – The development and use of business skills, businesses, and technological skills and technology are important spheres for Christians to operate in and tools for Christians to use to advance the Kingdom. Join us to discuss your experience in these spheres.

Gospel Proclamation – We live in a post-Christian, pluralistic society. How do we proclaim the Gospel in the 21st century? Come and share your experience.

Preparing for and Supporting Mission – Missionary recruitment and attrition are huge challenges for mission agencies. Having a wise and proactive community around a person being set-apart for ministry is a huge blessing. Join us to discuss how to send well, go well, and be supported well in ministry.

Disciple Making – What is a disciple and how do you multiply them? Join us for this urgent conversation and share your experience.

Justice (Social) - Part of the Christian calling is to care for those in need and thoughtfully address systemic issues like racism, reconciliation, and poverty. Join us to discuss what participation in social justice looks like as a Christian.

Local Mission and Church Planting – Join us to discuss what it means to be on mission at home.

Mission and the Arts – The arts influence culture. Join us to discuss how Christian artists can move beyond creating art for Christian consumption and influence the world with truth, beauty, and goodness.
